

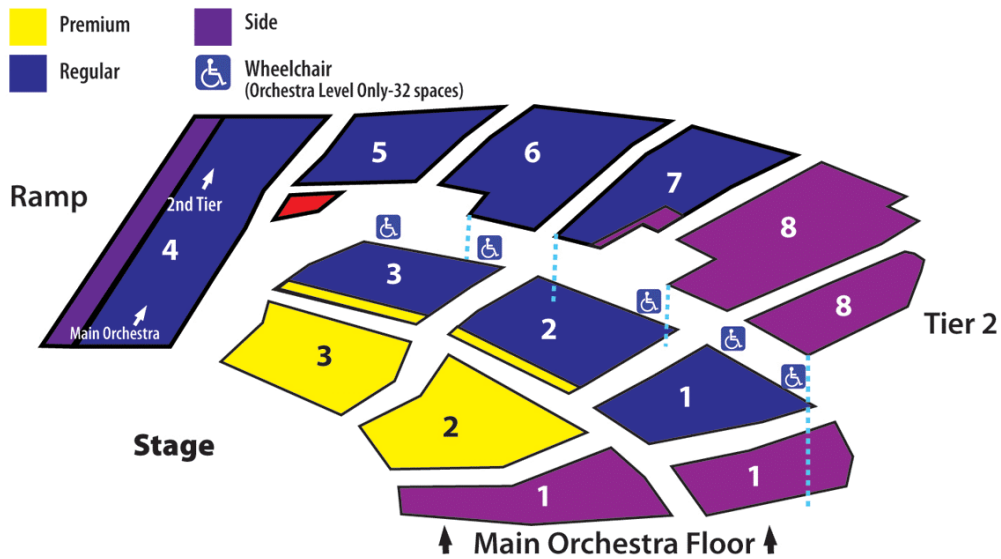
CALVARY WORSHIP CTR/THEATER SEATING IN GENERAL

Calvary’s worship center is a unique, contemporary, two-tiered, intimate Symphony hall with 1,350 comfortable theater seats. The theater’s acoustics are outstanding. A unique seating area of this theater is the “Ramp section” where rows start on the orchestra level and continue upward to the back of the 2nd tier. The curved seating and aisle design add to a nice experience in this hall.



The front center eight (8) rows are the most requested seats in the house. With 5 (five) inner aisles upstairs and four (4) aisles down stairs, most seats are no more than 7 (seven) seats from an aisle, making access easy. To reach the 2nd tier lobby, there is a circular ramp on the north side of the lobby and on the south lobby side there is a stairway. Wheelchair seating is available on the main floor, immediately inside the lobby doors. Both the north and south entrances are handicap accessible.

SECTION DESCRIPTIONS

Main Orchestra Floor

Premium Reserved Seats (*yellow*) These choice seats on the main orchestra floor of the theater are the first eight (8) rows in the two (2) center.

Main Orchestra Floor Regular Reserved Seating (*Blue*) These sections are located on the orchestra floor. These seats give you a nice, more elevated view of the musicians and the theater, simply a bit further from the stage.

Orchestra Side Reserved (*Purple*) These sections are the left & right sides of the theater and share the same proximity to the stage as other sections of the hall.

Ramp

Ramp Regular Reserved Seating (*Blue*) Regular seating is located on the right side of the theater. This unique section provides an overview of the entire theater with a wide choice of elevations. This area has the same superb acoustics as the full theater.

Ramp Side Reserved Seating (*Purple*) These are the four (4) seats in each row closest to the side aisle leading from the main floor to the second tier.

Second Tier

Second Tier Side Reserved (*Purple*) Like the rest of the ramp seating section, these are the four (4) seats in each row closest to the side aisle. Additionally, Section 8 and part of Section 7 that is along & above the sound booth is in this discounted ticket group.

Second Tier Regular Seating (*Blue*) These seats are among the choicest seats in the house because they give you a nice elevated view of the musicians and the theater.

Volunteer Seating (*Green*) These seats are reserved for the Pops volunteers only.

WHEEL CHAIR ACCESSIBLE SEATING, STAIRS, RESTROOMS

Main Orchestra Level Wheelchair Seating - The seats on the main floor are able to be reached with absolutely no stairs. All wheelchair seating (32 spaces) is on the main floor in a more level area at the rear of the theater.

Stairs All areas are accessible via stairs from within the theater and from the lobby. Additionally, there is a 3-story circular ramp that gently spirals up from the lobby all the way to the rear of the second tier lobby.

Restrooms These facilities are located on both the main floor and the 2nd tier. There is also a ladies lounge on the lobby level.

How to see views from various seating sections and purchase tickets online

- Click on to Purchase tickets online

Choose your preferred event.

Click on "Select Ticket"

- A view of the theater will appear.
- Hover your mouse over the seating sections and to see which are Available & Sold seats.
- Click on your section choice and then hover the mouse again over the sections' seats to see the view from that area.
